#### What is Positive Ageing Week?

Positive Ageing Week (PAW) is an annual opportunity to highlight the positive aspects of ageing and celebrate the contribution older people have made and continue to make in their communities. Its central aim is to dispel negative perceptions of ageing and transform attitudes towards ageing and older people.

#### How is it organised?

At national level, events are organised and co-ordinated by Age Action, and at local level, the Age Friendly Alliance which comprises local agencies and representatives of older people, facilitate and organise a range of activities and events. These events can be organised by the Agencies, or by Libraries, Local Community Groups, Nursing Homes, Active Retirement Associations, or individual older people themselves.

#### How can you help?

After the difficult year endured by older people due to cocooning and all its associated worries and anxieties and inability to take part in social activities, Galway's Age Friendly Alliance feel that it is more important than ever to showcase and celebrate our older people and the contribution they make to their communities. Therefore, we have started preparing for a range of activities and campaigns to take place during Positive Ageing Week 2021 and would really like to get your ideas and suggestions to ensure the whole week will be full of community activities and events which will truly celebrate positive ageing and all those of older age in our lives and neighbourhoods.

3.	Invite young people to come up with creative ideas to show how much they value the older people in their lives – these can then be showcased on social media and in other online or local media.					
4.	An art exhibition showcasing the theme of positive ageing.					
5.	Promotion - a lively and active social media presence across communities and agencies showcasing examples of the above, newspaper articles showcasing materials from the above projects and radio interviews and coverage throughout the week.
